# Treasurer's Notes

# Membership:

Membership count unchanged at 109. Members paid up for 2019 increased from 67% to 80% since October, still short of the target of 90% before January 2019. Only one new member recruited in the 2018 year. Of the seventeen transfers picked up in the 2018 year drive, all but one have yet to renew for 2019 – there is still hope. Unfortunately a couple of Gulf War members who joined us in 2017 through our Boy Scout affiliates failed to renew for 2018; their memberships and are now in expired status. If you know of a Veteran not affiliated with the Post or the American Legion please refer them to Bill Rahn – Post Adjutant.

## 2018 finances overview:

In 2018 the Post's income exceeded expenses for the third consecutive year. For those familiar with our past financial history, this is a significant accomplishment. We provided \$5,500, to five different Veteran Support groups, funds raised by the hard work of many members, the generosity of the public and local businesses including the Post Office \* who allowed us to distribute Poppies in memory of our deceased Veterans of Foreign Wars. We expensed \$5,180 on our youth programs and community events, \$4,216 for operations.

\*As of the end of May of this year Poppy Distribution on Post Office property was deemed off limits. The issue is under review by State Government and the USPS.
