I am instituting a policy that "rewards" those who participate in and help with our events (beginning July, 2018).

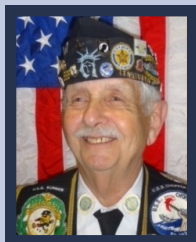
The menu for the meeting on November 14th is:

Hope to see you there.

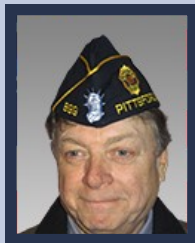
